

**NOTICE OF ELECTION**

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

**EL PASO COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT**

The El Paso County Community College District Board of Trustees hereby gives notice of an election to be held on May 9, 2015, for the purpose of electing one trustee each for positions designated as Trustee Electoral Districts 2 and 3. **(NOTE: District 2 only received one candidate and therefore the election has been cancelled in District 2 only.)**

from April 27, 2015 through May 5, 2015, the early voting clerk shall keep such absentee voting places open during such hours for absentee voting by personal appearance.

Applications for early voting ballots by mail should be mailed to the Early Voting Clerk, El Paso County Department of Elections, County Courthouse, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, 500 E. San Antonio Street, El Paso, Texas 79901. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on Thursday, April 30, 2015.

The POLLING PLACES designated below (being regular voting places of each precinct within each Trustee's Electoral District) will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election, Saturday, May 9, 2015. **The El Paso County Courthouse will only be available on Election Day, Saturday, May 9, 2015, for ADA and persons 65 years and older.**


