from April 29, 2013 through May 7, 2013, the early voting clerk shall keep such absentee voting places open during such hours for absentee voting by personal appearance.

Applications for early voting ballots by mail should be mailed to the Early Voting Clerk, El Paso County Department of Elections, County Courthouse, Room L115, 500 E. San Antonio Street, El Paso, Texas 79901. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on Wednesday, May 3, 2013.

The POLLING PLACES designated below (being regular voting places of each precinct within each Trustee's Electoral District) will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election, Saturday, May 11, 2013. **The El Paso County Courthouse will only be available on Election Day, Saturday, May 11, 2013, for ADA and persons 65 years and older.**
