**Comments for notes 1 – 11 of Testing Services Annual Report of Tests Administered
September 1, 2008 - August 31, 2009**

Compared to the 2007 - 2008 academic year, we administered approximately **20,164 MORE (14% increase from last year)** tests during this reporting year.

1. ACCU – The ACCUPLACER is an on-line, computerized, adaptive test format used at EPCC for Texas Success Initiative (TSI), course placement and ability to benefit (ATB) testing purposes. The standard test group for a new student's placement test consists of 4 – 6 tests: **Texas Writeplacer Essay** (w/Sentence Skills if Essay score is 5), **Arithmetic Skills, Elementary Algebra** (with College Level Math if indicated), and **Reading Comprehension**. There is an increase of **14,161 MORE** tests during this reporting year.
2. Dual Credit Testing (Off Campus) – We administered the ACCUPLACER on line tests in most of the local area high schools (public and private) to potential Dual Credit students. There is an increase of **3,412 MORE** tests during this reporting year.
3. Dual Credit (On Campus) – These are those Dual Credit students who missed the test date at the high school or preferred to test on campus or are retesting. There is an increase of **445 MORE** tests during this reporting year.
4. CELSA - Combined English Language Skills Assessment is a paper/pencil format test used for both course placement and ability to benefit purposes at EPCC for students whose first language is not English. On June 19, 2006, the passing score for the CELSA for ATB purposes increased from 90 to 97.
5. GED - EPCC currently operates the only official GED Testing Center in the entire El Paso area. Testing is available in both English and Spanish languages. GED Testing Center relocated to the Administrative Testing Services Center Building B on May 14, 2008.
6. National/State Tests - EPCC is an official testing center for a variety of national and state testing programs. Many of these programs support degree programs of EPCC. Others are offered as a community service for those seeking certification in their professional career. If EPCC were not a test site, these individuals would have to travel to centers in other cities to test.
7. Early College High Schools Partnerships
 - Mission Early College HS/Socorro ISD – 3rd year
 - Valle Verde Early College HS/Ysleta ISD – 2nd year EPCC
 - Northwest Early College HS /Canutillo ISD - 1st year
 - Transmountain Early College HS/1st year
8. Summer Bridge Program/Project Dream - Assisted testing for Irma Camacho using the Quick THEA
9. ACCU for “SISD Access” – tested SISD seniors who didn't receive their HS diploma and desired to enroll into EPCC in the summer at Mission del Paso.
