Phase II

Open to Phase I Graduates

Phase II is a 10-month program held from August to May and consists of monthly sessions designed to provide training and skills to enhance faculty performance. Each session will include both a theoretical/training component and an application component. Additionally, each session will include an assessment component, giving participants strategies to measure the effectiveness of any classroom changes or implementations. Upon completion of each session, participants are expected to be able to implement specific techniques and/or activities into their courses, and to have methods of assessing the effectiveness of these implementations. The following are representative topics that will be covered in the Mentor Teacher sessions.

- **Developing Faculty Leadership Skills**
- **Research and Publishing Component**
- **Scholarly Writing**
- **Recognizing the Importance of Student Engagement**
- **At Two Year Colleges, Critical Thinking is Critical Indeed**
- **Teaching with Technology: Tools and Strategies to Improve Student Learning**
- **Special Needs**

Academy participants will attend four-hour sessions in the ASC Boardroom from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on the third Thursday of every month.

Each participant will select a specific course in which to implement Academy topics, and will be asked to bring their selected course syllabus and other course materials to each workshop. By choosing a particular course and having that course's materials readily available, participants will be leaving each session with concrete applications of best practices, and will be able to immediately benefit from Academy participation.

The entire group of participants will be considered a cohort, from which individuals can experience collegiality and enhance their own faculty resource network. Teachership Academy participants are required to fulfill the following requirements:

- **Attendance at all sessions.**
- **Participation in all prescribed activities to include technology series.**
- **Maintain information and submit projects on a timely matter.**
- **Make use of TA Library and provided resources.**
- **Participate in virtual conference.**

Phase II - (Continued)

The Phase II Cohort will not exceed 30 participants. The Teachership Academy Steering Committee will review all application packets and will make their selection based on your response and Dean's nomination.

Upon completion of the Teacher Academy, participants will receive graduation recognition.

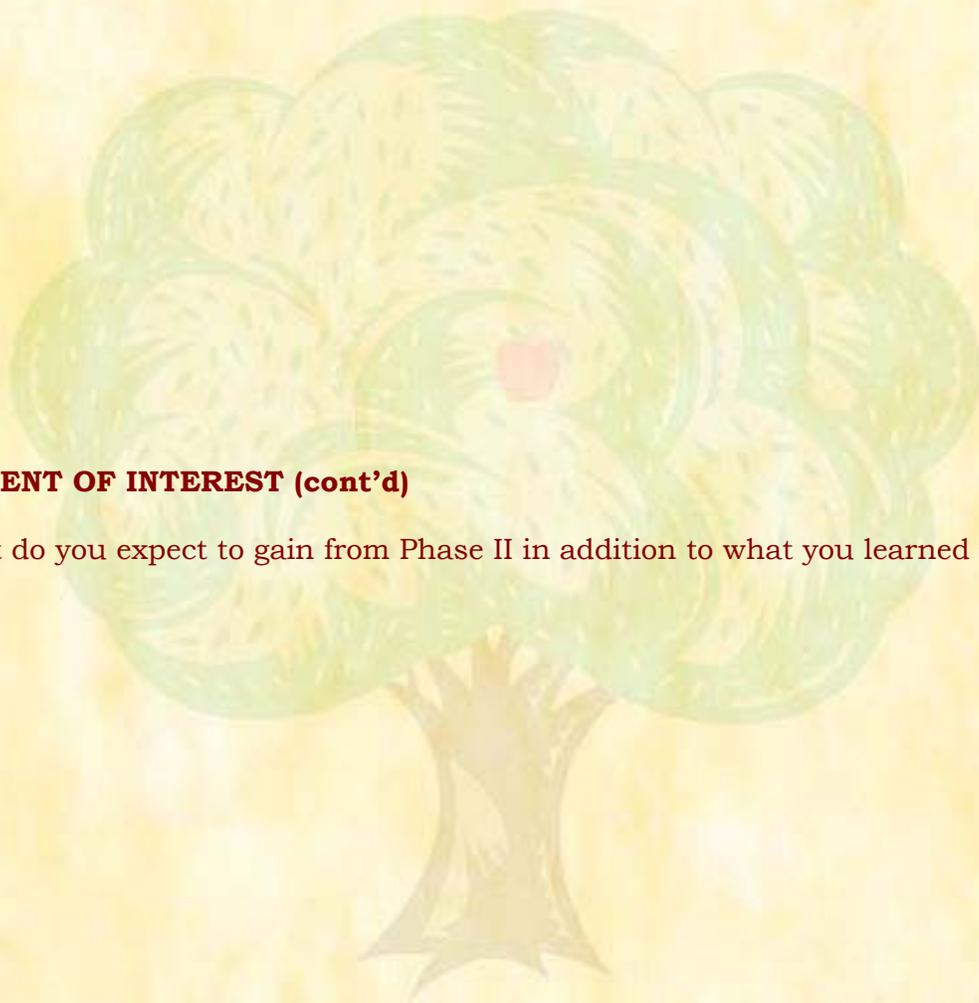
