What is Degree Works?

Degree Works is a web-based, degree-auditing and tracking tool that enables students and advisors to evaluate academic progress towards graduation in accordance to college and academic program requirements as they are outlined in the Catalog. This tool will allow students to quickly and easily identify which requirements have been satisfied, and which requirements are outstanding. Degree Works will replace the previous degree audit system (CAPP In addition, Degree Works can be used to perform a "what if" analysis to determine how current coursework and coursework in a student's academic history would be used if a different academic or career and technical program were selected.




