This one-semester Level One Certificate in Diabetes Prevention for Health Professions prepares individuals from various health programs, as well as community members and professionals working in the fields of health education who are already engaged with individuals with pre-diabetes, to help prevent or delay type 2 diabetes. Each of the six classes prepares individuals to better address the behaviors (such as healthy eating, weight management, physical activity, coping with stress, and behavior modification skills) necessary to prevent the onset of diabetes.
