In order to assist you in budgeting and preparing for the Program expenses, outlined below is an estimated cost for the next two years. The average costs for a two-year program in the US is \$36,463.00 (www.adha.org), El Paso Community College Dental Hygiene Program costs range between \$16,641.69 - \$18,291.69, substantially lower than the national average. Additional student expenses include transportation to off-campus rotation sites, schools, agencies, and/or other class activities.
