Special Note: An over-all score of 78% is required in order to pass the course. The faculty member assumes overall responsibility for teaching and evaluating the student.

The student will be evaluated at mid-term and at the end of the clinical rotation/preceptor ship. The preceptor will evaluate the student based on the criteria specified in the clinical evaluation tool. Points are to be awarded based on the level of performance observed by the preceptor using the specified legend. The student is expected to complete a self-evaluation and discuss the evaluation with the clinical preceptor. The clinical instructor will grade the written nursing care plan and the staff teaching. The student is expected to perform client teaching consistently based on identified learning needs however, the preceptor will select, observe and evaluate one of the student's teaching sessions. **The student must practice safely at all times in order to successfully complete the course.** It is the student's responsibility to seek out opportunities and provide information that indicates competencies have been met.

The clinical nursing instructor will make rounds on a weekly basis to discuss the student's performance and any areas of concern. In addition, a nursing faculty member will be available by beeper; cell phone and message center 24 hours a day.

CRITERIA FOR AWARDING POINTS

- All Points = Meets 100% of the criteria consistently with minimal supervision except in very complex situations
Is consistently self directed in his/her approach to learning; Demonstrates above average performance
Is consistently able to state theoretical knowledge and rationale for therapeutic nursing interventions;
- 3/4 Points = Meets 75% of the criteria with minimal supervision over time; Recognizes learning opportunities but may require assistance
Demonstrates average performance of nursing care; is usually able to state theoretical knowledge and rationale for therapeutic Interventions
- 1/2 Points = Meets 50% of the criteria with moderate amount of supervision and guidance; requires minimal direction in recognizing and utilizing learning opportunities; demonstrates below average performance of nursing care; is not consistently able to state theoretical knowledge and rationale for therapeutic interventions
- 1/4 Points = Meets 25% of the criteria with intense supervision and guidance; requires detailed instruction regarding learning opportunities
Demonstrates below average performance of nursing care; demonstrates gaps in necessary knowledge and rationale for therapeutic interventions
- 0 Points = Does not meet criteria at this time; requires constant, detailed instruction regarding learning opportunities; is considered unsafe to practice without constant, intense guidance; lacks necessary knowledge and skills; OR criteria not met due to excessive absences
