**JOB SUMMARY:** Responsible for providing tutorial, training, and instructional lab assistance and support to students, instructors, and laboratory personnel in the lab setting.

1.	Assist students with course and laboratory assignments; assist the instructor to demonstrate and review material covered in use of equipment and materials.	30%
2.	Assist in the preparation of setting up lab equipment and supplies necessary to conduct laboratory assignments; ensure laboratory equipment is maintained; troubleshoot and perform routine equipment maintenance and repairs.	25%
3.	Monitor the activities of students and staff to insure a safe learning environment; provide orientation to students in the use of the laboratory, equipment, and supplies.	25%
4.	Develop and maintain an inventory system for instructional materials, equipment, and tools; maintain usage records and monitor material returned.	10%
5.	Issue tools, materials, and equipment to students and instructors; coordinate distribution and retrieval of classroom and lab resources.	5%
6.	Perform other duties as assigned.	5%
