OBJECTIVE: To establish the guidelines in processing warrants, summons, and subpoenas of student and staff arrests from

law enforcement agencies.

PROCEDURE:

I. Notifications

A warrant of arrest by any officer on a student or staff must be directed to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) before a warrant is served.

II. District Representation

A representative from the DPS will accompany the law enforcement officer to the designated location.

III. District Reporting Follow-up

The DPS will contact the appropriate Dean or Vice President and forward a report copy.
