El Paso Community College (EPCC) accepts transfer credits from any college or university accredited through a regional accrediting body. EPCC is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), and is required to have transcripts for each student from **all** institutions previously attended. In order to be considered "official", transcripts must be sent directly to EPCC by the issuing institution (college, university or HS/GED). This requirement is mandated by SACS in order for EPCC to maintain its accreditation. **Hand carried or transcripts mailed or emailed by student will not be accepted.** 

Where applicable, transcripts will be evaluated for undergraduate credit and transcripted to your current EPCC academic record. Upper division and Graduate courses do not transfer.

Transfer of credits from a foreign college or university also follow SACS guidelines. You will need to provide credit recommendations from a recognized credentials evaluation agency (NACES.org/members).
