Student Parent Resource Center Guidelines

EPCC Student Parent Resource Centers welcome children of all ages, however, for their safety and comfort as well as in recognition of the rights and privileges of other users of EPCC facilities, parents are asked to observe the following: EPCC staff reserves the right to ask any individual who is interfering with the use of the Student Parent Resource Center to leave.

1. Parent/Caregiver must supervise their child(ren) at all times while they are in these spaces. Children cannot be dropped off and left unattended. (Note: YWCA on-campus child care available at VV and TM, plus any of the other El Paso area YWCA locations, and other child care providers, some located near other campuses).

2. EPCC staff will not take responsibility for monitoring the safety or behavior of unattended children.

3. EPCC strives to provide an atmosphere conducive to study and children are expected to behave in an orderly manner just as we expect from all users. Loud, noisy or disruptive behavior is inappropriate and children, with their caregiver, will be asked to leave if this type of behavior persists.

4. Student Parent Resource Center equipment and materials should be treated with care and respect. Please do not damage, deface, or remove any materials.

5. EPCC staff are not responsible for any lost or stolen items, users are responsible for their personal belongings.

6. Parent/Caregivers are asked to make sure any toys/supplies that their children use be put away before they leave the space.

7. Students can use the computers for as long as they need, unless there are other students waiting. Staff will implement a 30-minute time limit when needed.

8. Students are allowed to print up to 10 pages per day.

9. Do not place any food or drinks on the computer tables.

10. Students should save their work in a flash drive or cloud storage to avoid losing any documents in case of computer malfunction.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in the loss of space use privileges. All users should follow the EPCC student code of conduct.

By following these guidelines, EPCC can provide a welcoming and productive environment for all users, including families and children.
