## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Please Note: Testing Center staff may provide general information regarding CLEP tests and administer the tests. Testing Center staff are not permitted to advise you about which tests you should take, minimum passing score(s) required, or the courses that you will receive credit for by taking a CLEP test.

Before taking any test for award of credit you should check with the appropriate office/academic advisors at the institution where you are seeking college credit based on CLEP. You should ask:

- What courses at this institution may be completed with CLEP tests?
- What are the minimum passing scores needed for award of credit?
- Are there any other requirements that I must meet in order to receive credit?
- What is the process I should follow to receive credit at this institution?

At El Paso Community College (EPCC), the Evaluations Office staff can provide you the most current information on credit that may be awarded at EPCC, the minimum score required, and any other requirements that may apply to your specific educational needs/goals.

The Evaluations Office is located at the Valle Verde Campus, in the Enrollment Services Center - Admissions and Registration Office (915-831-2FÍ €).

**\$20.00** Administration fee paid to EPCC is due upon registration. This fee is valid for 30 days and is non-refundable.

Once you create an account on the CLEP website and pay the \$95.00 examination fee, then you will be able to schedule an appointment for testing at EPCC. You will need to provide the *Ticket ID* number on your CLEP Exam Registration Ticket to make an appointment.

On the test date, please report to the Valle Verde Campus, Bldg. C-212, (919 Hunter Dr, El Paso, TX 79915). You will be required to bring a printout of your CLEP Exam Registration Ticket and present your valid government-issued ID bearing your name, signature and recognizable photo (Examples: Driver License, Passport, Military ID, etc). Identification needs to include your full name in English language characters, exactly as it appears on your ticket (including the order of the names).

#### **SCORE REPORTING**

For most exams, you will receive an unofficial score report immediately following your testing session. Your official test scores will be sent (usually within two weeks) from CLEP to the institution you designated to receive your official scores.
